'Family' Structure:

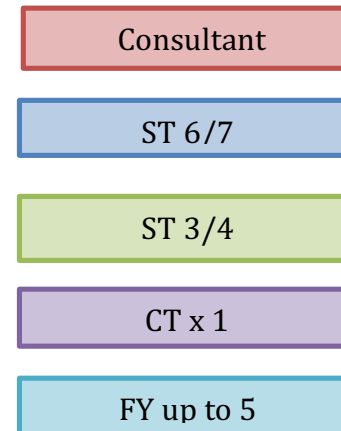
Eligibility:

- Specialty registrars based within OUH

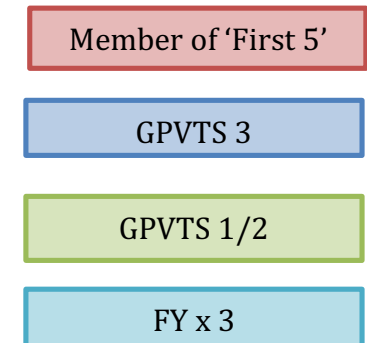
What does it involve?
